

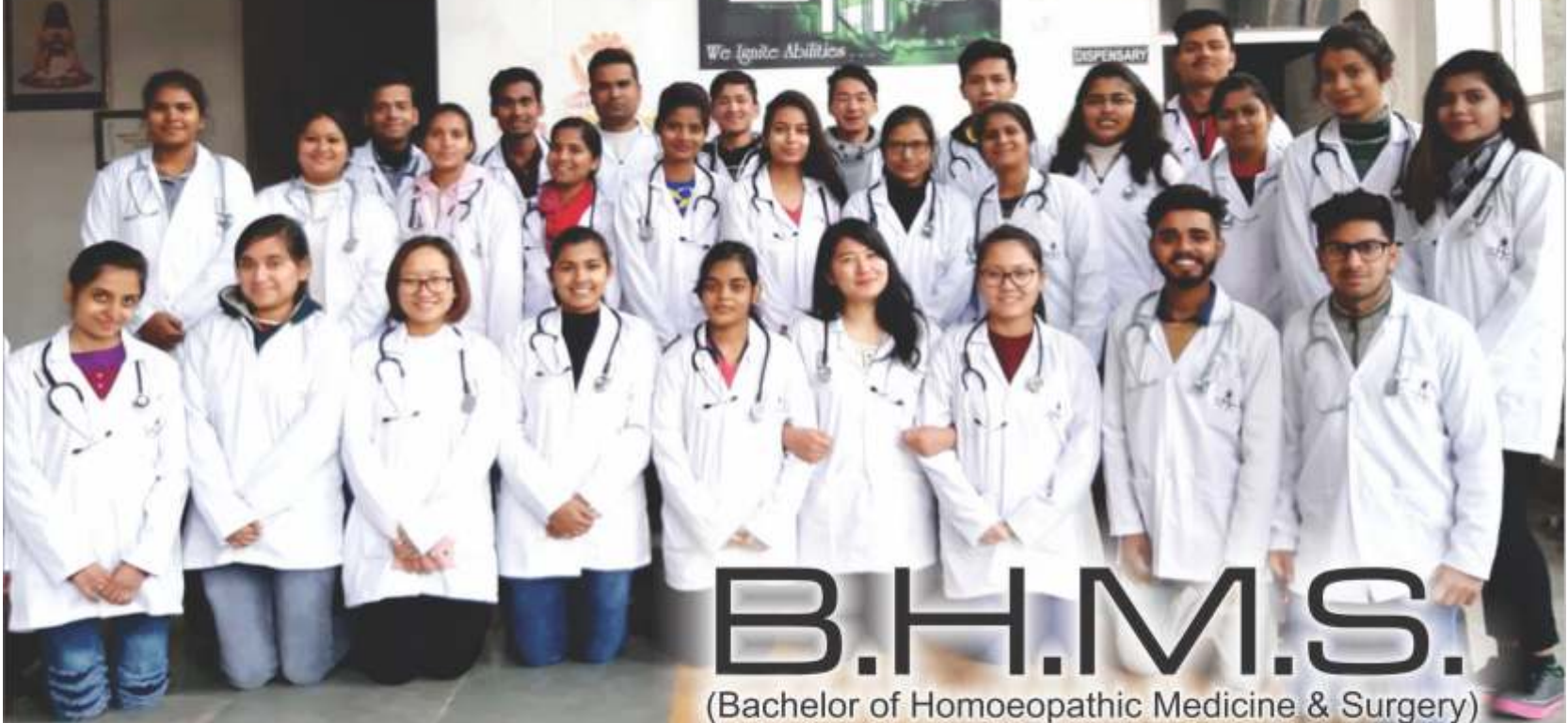

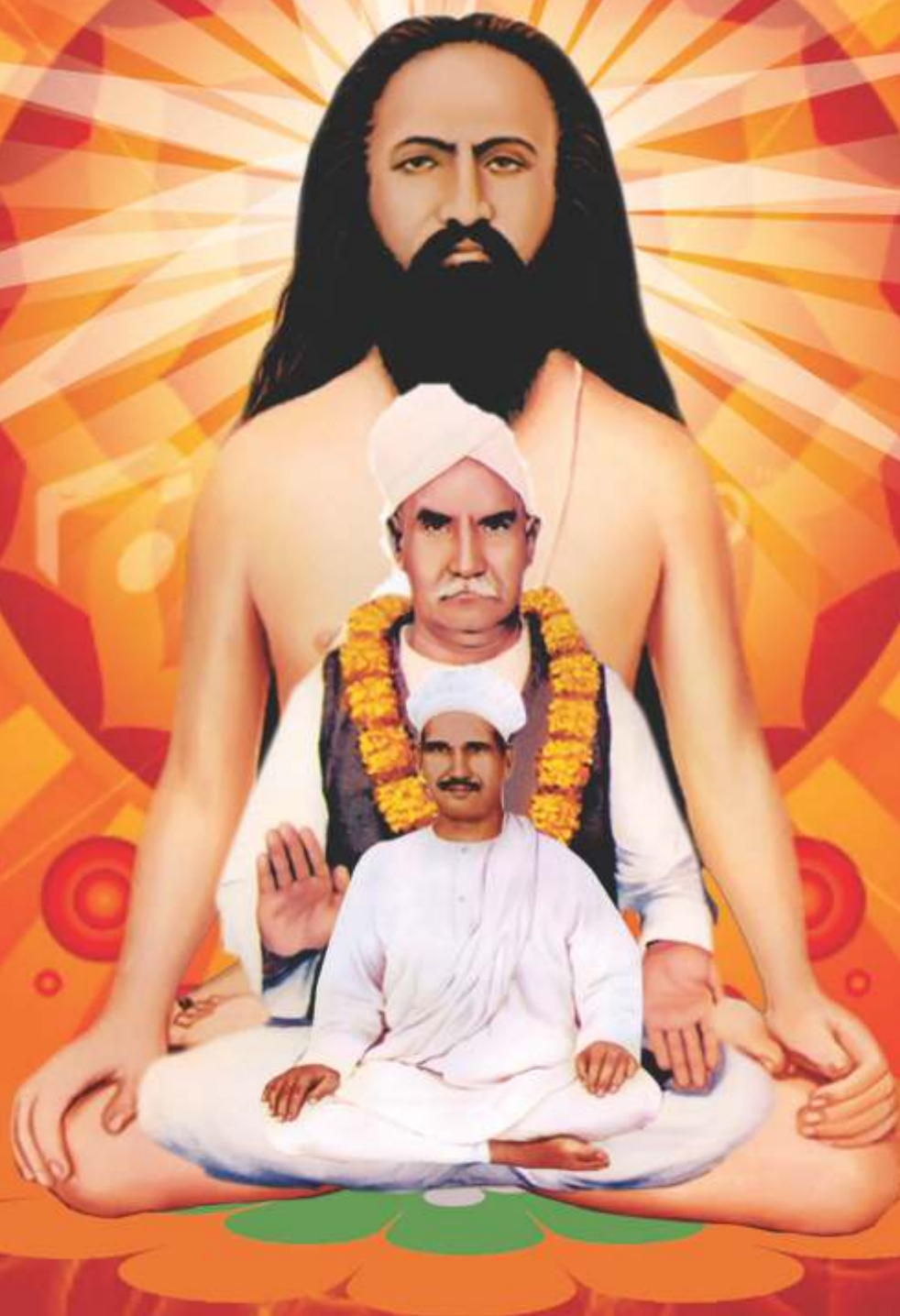


# A Tribute

### INTERNSHIP

# Admission Procedure

Admission to the First Prof. of B.H.M.S. course (current session) for State Quota as well as Central Quota/ All India Quota shall be made on the basis of NEET Entrance Examination of current year.

## Eligibility :

1. The candidate should have passed 10+2 with minimum 50% marks for general category and minimum 40% for SC, ST and OBC Categories from H.P. Board of School Education or from recognized board equivalent degree/ examination passed with Science (Medical group with Physics, Biology, Chemistry and English) of the University / H.P. Board of School Education in science subjects.
2. The candidate should have completed the age of 17 years as on 31st December of current year.
3. Blind (including Colour blind), deaf and / or dumb candidates shall not be allowed for admission in the course.

## Duration of the Course :

The duration of B.H.M.S. (Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery) course will be of five and a half years including one year compulsory rotatory internship, as per Central Council of Homoeopathy regulations.

English will be the medium of instructions & examination for B.H.M.S. Course.

Regular classes for the session will begin within one month from the date of counseling.

## FEE STRUCTURE

### Annual Fee :

1. Tuition Fee: Rs. 1,10,000/- (Rs. One Lakh Ten Thousand only).
2. Medical Fund : Rs 625/- ( Rs . Six hundred Twenty Five Only)
3. Library Fund : Rs 625/- ( Rs . Six hundred Twenty Five Only)
4. Lab Maintenance Fund : Rs 625/- ( Rs . Six hundred Twenty Five Only)

Fee for subsequent years must be submitted before 10th July of each calendar year in a single installment.

**Caution Money :** (One time, at the time of admission): Rs. 10,000/- [Rupees Ten Thousand only] Refundable without interest at the time of completion of the course or after 5 ½ years from date of admission in case the candidate leaves the college for any reason before completion of the B.H.M.S course.

**Hostel Fee :** (For girl students only) Rs. 66000/- [Rupees Sixty Six Thousand only] annually including board & lodging. An advance of six months Rs. 33000/- (Rupees Thirty Three Thousand only) is to be deposited on confirmation of admission. This facility is available on first come first served basis.

We also facilitate PG accommodation for male candidates in the vicinity of the college.

Fee for Clinical Training Rs.10000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand only) shall be charged extra alongwith B.H.M.S. 3rd Prof annual fee.

In case a students leave before completion of the BHMS course, he/ she is liable to pay the entire course fee.

### Note :

1. Any other type of University fee shall be charged extra, as applicable from time to time.
2. Fee for clinical training in Regional Hospital, Solan is subject to revision as amended by the State Govt. from time to time, will be charged extra, as applicable.
3. College fee can be submitted in the college account in the name of Health Trust of India, Account No. : 0433002100071704 in Punjab National Bank, The Mall, Solan (H.P.), IFSC - PUNB0043300.

### Medical Examination

The selected candidates are required to submit Medical Certificate of fitness from any Government Dispensary / Hospital after allotment of seat in the institution. They should get themselves vaccinated against Anti-Hepatitis B at their own expense.







# Campus

**All the students  
shall comply with the  
college rules and regulations**

1. Regular and punctual attendance in all class activities like lectures, practicals, clinical, tutorials and tests as well as in all college activities like guest lectures, seminars, sports and cultural & extra curricular activities are compulsory. Each student must maintain the minimum percentage of attendance (i.e. 75%) required in all the classes and college activities. Students, whose conduct and academic standards are found unsatisfactory, shall not be allowed to take the University examinations. Any student who remains absent without intimation shall be fined @ Rs.10/- per day.
2. A deficiency in the required number of lectures, clinical and practical may be condoned by the Principal, under special circumstances, to the extent of 10%.
3. Leave of absence from the classes must be taken from the Class Incharge. In case of illness, exceeding 15 days a medical certificate from a Government Hospital duly stamped must be sent immediately.
4. If a student has a break of more than three weeks at a stretch in an academic session, his/her name will be struck off the rolls.
5. Students are not allowed to paste notices within the Institution without prior permission from the office of the Principal and are also forbidden to communicate with any outside authority directly. All such communications must be submitted through the Principal, who will forward these if considered suitable. Any student infringing this rule may be suspended.
6. Students must wear their aprons and Identity Cards daily. They should come in college uniform on specified days as per office instructions. Expenses for aprons & uniforms will be borne by the students themselves.
7. The college does not hold itself responsible for debts incurred by the students in any way.
8. Students must pay for all damages caused by them to library books and other college property. The students will pay for breakages of the apparatus, in excess of Rs.5/-
9. The following are STRICTLY FORBIDDEN within the premises of the institution.
  - (i) Possession or use of alcoholic beverages.
  - (ii) Possession or use of addictive or hallucinogenic drugs.
  - (iii) Smoking & gambling.
  - (iv) Possession or use of firearms or any lethal weapons.
  - (v) Loitering around, especially under the influence of alcohol.
  - (vi) Use of mobile phones.







# Rules

10. The Hon'ble High Court in its order CWP No. 310 of 2004 has upheld the ban imposed by the state Govt. on Holding the gate meetings and slogan shouting etc. in Medical Colleges, Hospitals & Hostels attached there to within a distance of 500 meters from these institutions. Violator can be prosecuted against for committing contempt of Hon'ble High Court. This is apart from other suitable punitive action.
11. RAGGING of students has been banned by a court order and is strictly FORBIDDEN. Ragging is defined as willful injury, physical or mental to any fellow student. It also includes willfully degrading or humiliating a fellow student, whereby he/she suffers distress to mind or spirit (SEE ANTI RAGGING POLICY).
12. College fees must be paid in full by the due dates. Any students whose fees, together with the fine imposed found unpaid will be suspended from attending lectures, practicals, clinical classes etc. until the fees, dues have been paid. All dues must be cleared before filling of examination forms.
13. All irregularities, neglect of duties, breach of rules and indiscipline brought to the notice of the Principal, who in consultation with senior staff members shall deal with the same as a serious offence, for which an adverse entry in personal files/student record register will be made. The penalty may either be a written or verbal warning, fine, suspension and/or removal as an office bearer of any committee and/or removal/expulsion from the college. The Principal is competent to remit the fine imposed by him.
14. In case a student leaves the course before completion due to any reason, he/she is liable to pay complete course fee to the institution.
15. Students are advised to read the notice board for all sorts of information. Ignorance of any fact circulated through any notice for reason of non-perusal of the notice on the part of any student for whatever reason shall not entitle him/her to any special treatment.
16. Taking pictures of any kind within the college premises without written permission is strictly forbidden.
17. Students must inform the office, if they change their address with telephone numbers. If they fail to do so, they will be held responsible for any lack of communication from the office.
18. The decision of the College in all disputes would be final and binding on the students.

## NOTE:

- i. University Examination fee (As applicable) for each examination is to be paid at the time of submission of examination forms.
- ii. Fee for clinical training in Regional Hospital will be charged extra, as applicable (Currently it is Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) during B.M.H.S. 3rd Prof.)
- iii. Any other type of fee levied by the university shall be charged extra. The fee structure is subject to revision and amendment from time to time as per the direction from Govt. and the revised structure will be applicable irrespective of the structure prescribed in this Bulletin.



# STOP RAGGING



## Anti Ragging Policy

Quality Homoeopathic medical education and moral values being the core driving ethics of Solan Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, towards turning out professionals of high caliber with strong sense of ethical judgements, social integration of students population coming from different parts of the country with most divers cultrual and social back grounds becomes a matter of prime importance.

- 1) 'Ragging' a social menace, as such has no place in academic environment of the college and determined efforts are required to be in place to prevent its accurrence at any point of time, Hence a balanced "anti ragging policy is adopted by the institution. An "Anti-Ragging committee" has been formed and brought into operation. Notice that displays the name of committee memebers can be seen on the college notice board.
- 2) Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, during Decemeber 2007 has expressed concern over the incidents of ragging accuring in higher educational institutions and the need to eliminate it altogether.
- 3) The report of the Raghavan Committee constituted as per directions of the Supreme Court of India had already been adopted by the University Grants Commission.
- 4) The Ministry of Human Resource Development Govt. of India has taken a serious note of the incidents of ragging and is of the view that stern action should be taken against those indulging in "ragging" so that these incidents are not repeated and exemplary punishment is meted out to those indulging in it.
- 5) Ragging is a criminal offence and lowers the standard of education. The "anti-ragging policy" adopted by the institutions takes care of preventive, procedural and punitive aspects of ragging based on the guidelines provided by Hon'ble Supreme court of India, recommendations of the Raghavan Committee instructions guidelines issued by the university Grants Commission, Ministry of HRD (Govt. of India) and Govt. of Himahal Pradesh

## I. Policy Objective

This policy encourages socialization of students to the academic environment of the institution simultaneously discouraging and preventing any negative acts on parts of senior students, which goes against the basic purpose of socio academic integration. The 'anti-ragging policy' adopted by the institution therefore is aimed at :

1. Creation, development and nurturing a conducive, socio-academic environment within the student population.
2. Generating and maintaining a high level of confidence among new entrants and their parents/guardians to perceive that fresh entrants to the institutions are welcome and provided support rather than being harassed and intimidated.
3. Prescribing deterrent measures for any violation of the "Anti-Ragging Policy" by way of disciplinary measures.



## II. Definitions

For the purpose of this policy

1. "Institution" means solan Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital
2. 'Student' includes any person who is enrolled for B.H.M.S. course, with the institution including interns.
3. 'Hostel'-includes the place where freshers are accommodated through institutional or private arrangements.
4. **Ragging' is defined as:**

Any disorderly conduct, whether by words spoken or written or by an act, which has the affect of teasing or handling with rudeness any other students, rowdy or undisciplined activities, which cause or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior students or asking the students to do any act or perform something. which such students will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment, so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

Ragging has several aspects among others psychological, social, political, economic, cultural and academic dimensions. The psychological aspects of ragging are seen to cause permanent damage to the victims personality. Such treatment of young and impressionable minds could result in traumatizing them and damaging their personalites beyond repair in the formative years of their lives.

## III. Preventive aspects of Ragging

### 1. Address of the Principal, Administrative officer and Department in Charges

Principal, Administrative officer and Departmental Incharge, During their discussions with parents/guardians, admission aspirants/fresh students at the time of counseling meets, new batch inaugurals and other such occasions, should invariably assure the students and parents about full protection and support against any attempts of ragging by seniors while briefly introducing the "Anti Ragging Policy" of the institution. The efforts during such meets be directed towards achieving socio-academic integration of new students with the specific merit oriented enviornment of mutuality and trust of the institution.

### 2. Fresher's Party

Seniors, be encouraged to organize. "Welcome party" for new entrants. For this purpose an organizing committee will be constituted out of senior students to whom a senior faculty member will supervise. Such a party, by senior students, be organized within first month, of the begining of academic session.

#### Mentoring Cell

The institution has a "Mentoring Cell" functioning under guidance of senior faculty and in direct supervision of the Principal. There are two senior students (one male and one female) mentors for a specified group of 10 junior students. Membership to the 'Mentoring Cell' by senior students would be on voluntary basis by inviting applications and nominating membership on yearly basis.

#### Watch and Ward arrangements.

Each mentor should identify all vulnerable locations, and ensure keeping a constant vigil and watch at such locations including monitoring of the atmosphere and the environment at eating 'Joints' (Canteens, Cafes, 'Khoka' Dhabas etc) Hostel/accommodations, where freshers are accommodated, are required to be carefully guarded if necessary, by posting security personnel and / or supervision of a warden.





## Declaration by the Candidates

The candidates accepting the offer of the admission have to sign the following undertaking:

### Undertaking by the Candidate

I certify and gone through the 'Anti Ragging Policy' of the Solan Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, and I agree to sign the declaration regarding the 'Anti Ragging' and also submit the same countersigned by my parents/guardians at the time of admission.

I am aware that ragging is banned in the Solan Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital and if I am found guilty of ragging, I will be liable for appropriate punishment, which may include expulsion from the institution.

## IV. Procedural and Punitive Aspects

### A. Ragging Reporting Procedure

- i) If any individual believes that he or she has been subjected to ragging or has knowledge of any such incident, such person shall have option to file a complaint with the Principal. This may be done in writing or orally. Written complaint is preferable.
- ii) Members of the 'Enquiry Committee' will also be available to discuss any concern exhibited by any student or a group of students, about ragging.
- iii) All formal/Informal complaints of "ragging" may be made to the Principal as soon as possible.

### B. Enquiry Committee (EC)

A three member enquiry committee (of which one will be a female member) to be nominated by the Principal will investigate all reported cases of ragging. in such a way, so as to maintain confidentiality to the extent practicable under the circumstances. The investigations should start within 3 days of reporting the incident and reports finalized by the enquiry committee pinpointing the involvement of the accused along with recommendations relating to the punishment, will be submitted to the Principal within a period of 2 weeks. In exceptional circumstances. The principal may grant extension to the time limit under information to the complainant and the accused.

### C. Process of Enquiry

The process of enquiry should be such to ensure that principles of natural justice are adhered to.

#### D. Punishment/Penalties for 'ragging'

Based on the report of enquiry submitted by the 'Enquiry Committee' the Principal will be empowered to impose any of the punishment(s) listed below or any other kind of punishment, which he may consider to be appropriate.

- i. Withholding scholarships or other benefits.
- ii. Debarring from representation of events.



- iii. Withholding results
- iv. Expulsion from hostel/mess.
- v. Debarring from examination(s)
- vi. Suspension from the class for a limited period.
- vii. Fine with public apology
- viii. Prosecuting for criminal offence
- ix. Filing FIR with the local Police
- x. Cancellation of admission/expulsion from the institution.
- xi. Collective punishment in case the individual(s) committing or abetting "ragging" are not identified.

#### E. Appeal

Appeal with regards to any action taken against the accused at any level and/or against the punishment awarded under this policy by the Principal shall lie with the Chairman, which should be filed within a period of two weeks from such an action or awarded punishment.

#### V. Saving and Repeal Clause

Chairman of the solan Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital will pass the sole authority for any interpretation, modification or amendment to the policy depending upon the need from time to time. He will also possess powers to exercise his discretion with respect to any or all of the clauses of this policy.

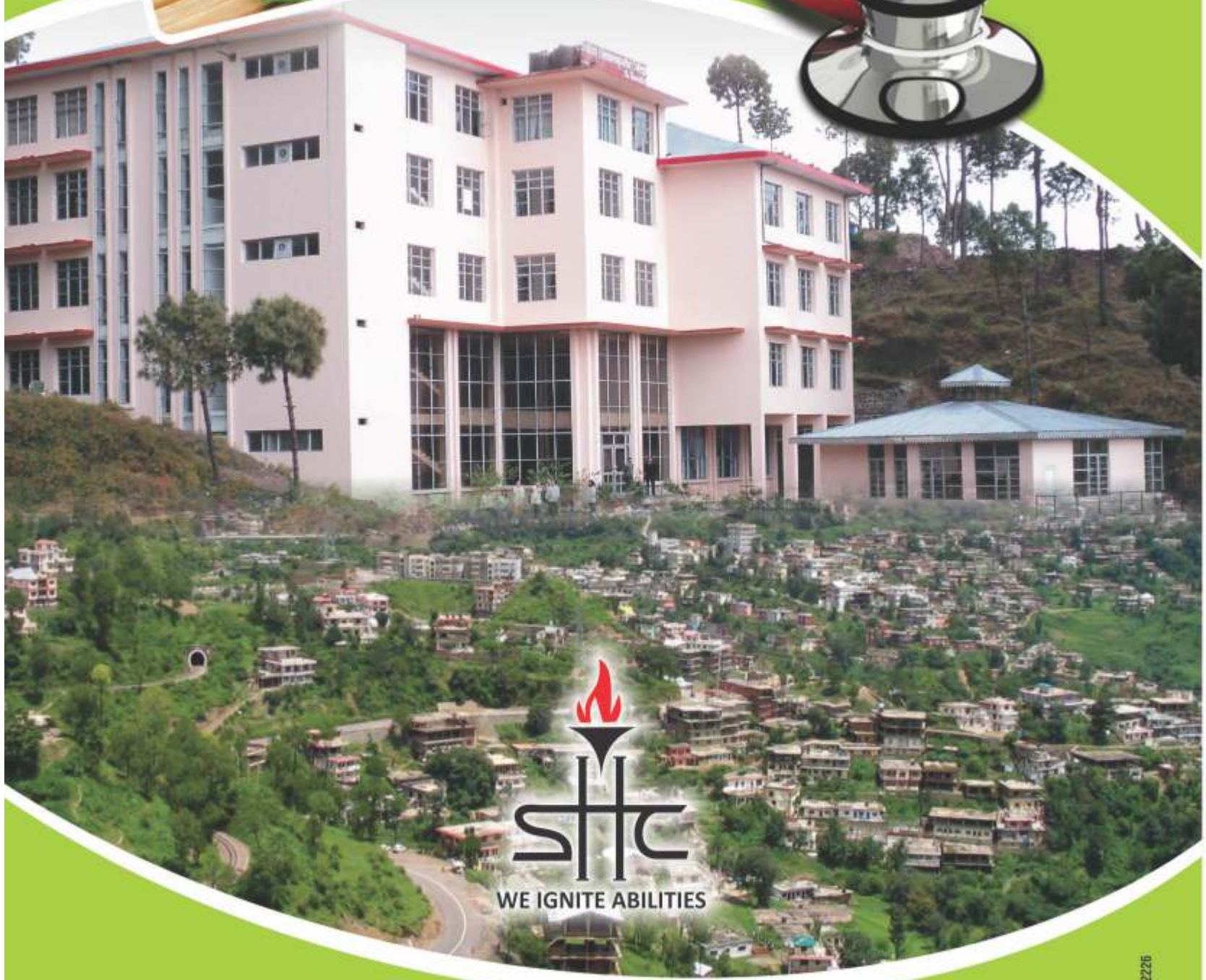
